**Davis Riley (Winner/-14)**

- Picks up his second PGA TOUR victory in his 90th start at the age of 27 years, 5 months, 9 days
- Earns first individual victory on TOUR (2023 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Nick Hardy)
- Earns 500 points to move to No. 55 in the FedExCup standings and entry in the two remaining Signature Events this season (the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, Travelers Championship)
- Moves from No. 250 to No. 78 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Improves to 1-for-2 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2<sup>nd</sup>/2022 Valspar Championship, won/2024 Charles Schwab Challenge)
- Becomes the seventh 36-hole leader/co-leader and 16<sup>th</sup> 54-hole leader/co-leader to go on to win this season
- 266 marks career-low 72-hole total (267/three times; most recent: 2022 CJ CUP Byron Nelson/T9)
- Victory comes in his third start at the Charles Schwab Challenge (T4/2022, MC/2023, won/2024)
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (11.416) and Total Birdies this week (21)
- Moves to

**Additional Player Notes**

- Six-time PGA TOUR winner **Keegan Bradley** (T2/-9) finishes runner-up for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in his TOUR career and second time this season (lost in a playoff to Grayson Murray at the Sony Open in Hawaii); second time in his TOUR career with multiple runner-up finishes in a season (2013)
- With a final-round 1-over 71, FedExCup leader and World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** (T2/-9) records his first over-par final round since the 2023 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard (73/T4); marks ninth runner-up finish on TOUR and 11<sup>th</sup> top-10 of the season, most of any player
- PGA TOUR Rookie and Plano, Texas native **Pierceson Coody** (T5/-5) posts best result in his 23<sup>rd</sup> PGA TOUR start (previous: T14/2023 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard); moves to No. 5 in the Aon Swing 5, as players vie to earn a spot in the next Signature Event (the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday) based on their play in the Myrtle Beach Classic, Charles Schwab Challenge and RBC Canadian Open
